
PCS Family Members:

The New York State Education Department has updated its guidance on feeding children during this school closure. The following is a detailed description of our updated food security plan:

- Eligibility
 - o The Perry Central School District's application to provide reimbursable meals during the extended closure has been approved by the New York State Education Department.
 - o School Food Authorities must provide meals to all low-income children during school closures related to COVID-19 **and to every child who comes to their meal sites.**
 - o **Meals will be available for every child in the District.**
- Food Preparation
 - o Cooks and selected food service staff will be deemed essential to prepare these meals.
 - o Meal preparation will occur in the Elementary/Junior High School Kitchen.
 - o Meals will consist of non-perishable items and be bagged for distribution.
 - o One (1) breakfast and one (1) lunch will be included in each bag.
- Meal Distribution
 - o **Meals will be available for pick-up in the Elementary/Junior High School bus loop from 11:00 AM to 1:00 PM Monday through Friday.**
 - o A food service staff member will distribute bags directly to vehicles or pedestrians in the bus loop.
 - o In the event an individual cannot pick-up their meals at the Elementary/Junior High School, District officials will deliver meals upon request. Please contact Molly Bogle ((585) 237 – 0270 ext. 1001 or mbogle@perry.k12.ny.us) to arrange for delivery.
- Food Safety
 - o Please contact Molly Bogle if your student has a dietary restriction or food allergy.
 - o Meals that are not consumed immediately are to be refrigerated.
